

Detroit Public Schools Facility Consolidation and Reinvestment Plan

Highlights

- 28 building closures
- Reducing operating space by over 2 million sq. ft. (11%)
- Estimated Annual Savings: \$14 Million
- Two New Schools Planned with Federal Stimulus Funds
 - Finney High School (\$70 Million)
 - Brightmoor Academy Pk-8 (\$36 Million)
- \$20 Million Invested in Receiving Schools
 - Improved Lighting
 - Safe and Secure Schools
 - Science and Curriculum Enhancements
- DPS buses to transport Finney and Chadsey High Schools to new locations
- Nine (9) schools expanded to K-8 Model
- Pre-Kindergarten Programs Added to Seven (7) Locations
- Private Management Company to Take Over Operations of Two Reconfigured Pk-8 Schools
