

# No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Supplemental Educational Services (“Free Tutoring”) 2008-2009 Fall Session

## PARENT INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

### What are Supplemental Educational Services (SES)?

SES are free tutoring sessions in mathematics and/or English Language Arts for eligible students who are attending Title I schools within the Detroit Public Schools District.

### Who is eligible?

Students attending a Detroit Public School that has not made AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress) for 3 years or more, who must be approved for free or reduced lunch.

### Where will services be provided?

Services will be provided in the schools that have not made AYP, and/or at the Providers’ offsite locations.

### Who will provide tutoring for my child?

Michigan-State approved Supplemental Educational Providers will provide tutors for this program.

### Do I have the option of choosing the location?

You can select (1) the school your child attends or (2) the Provider’s office of your choice. This is a parent driven program.

### How can I register my child?

Registration application forms were mailed to your home. They can also be picked up at your child’s school or at our central office in the Albert Kahn Building. .

### What important dates should I remember?

**Registration is from Tuesday, September 2 until 4:00 p.m., Friday, October 3. Your forms must be returned to: The Division of Curriculum & Instruction, Albert Kahn Bldg., 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, 7430 Second Ave., Detroit, MI 48202. They must be received at that office by the registration deadline. The Tutoring Program will begin on Monday, November 3.**

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

**Vendor Selection Process:** A total of 73 vendors have been selected to provide the tutoring services for this year’s program. Three providers were randomly selected for each school. This process was approved by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE). The providers that were servicing students in school buildings last year will remain in those schools for a second year.
