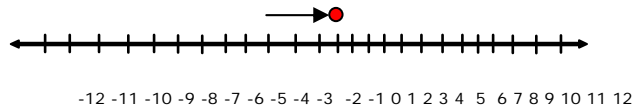


Addition of Integers – Homework 3

**Example: Use number line to
Add: $-5 - (-3)$**

Step 1 : We know that two like signs become a positive sign. So two signs of minus between -5 and 3 become positive $-5 + 3$

First locate -5 and move three numbers from -5 .



Answer: -2
