

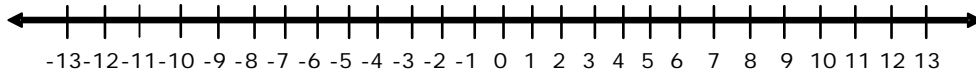
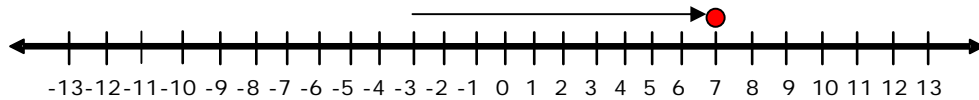
Addition of Negative Integers– Homework 1

Example: Use a number line to add $-3 + 10$

Step 1: First we draw a number line and follow the rules.

Step 2: We have to move right on number line and if we have to subtract we have to move left on the number line.

Step 3: Locate -3 on the number line and we have to add 10 (as 10 has positive sign) so we will count 10 numbers to the right of -3
