Cellphone policy – Smartphones must be off or on silent during the school day Monday through Friday. (7:30 AM – 2:40 PM) If a student is caught with their cellphone out or using it during school hours, the following two consequences will apply to your child.

1st Offense:

- The student's phone will be taken.
- The parent will be called.
- The phone will be returned to the students at the end of the day.

2nd Offense:

- The student's phone will be taken.
- The parent will be called.
- The parent must make arraignments with the teacher to pick up the phone.

Late Student Pick Up – Students that aren't picked up ***after 3:40 PM*** will be dropped off at **Safety Net**. Safety Net is location at 8145 Greenfield Detroit, MI 48228 (Westside Bus Terminal) and the contact number is 313-945-8600. This information will also be placed on our school website under the category entitled "**Safety Net**".

COVID – 19 School-Wide Expectations – All students (K-8th) must adhere to our COVID – 19 expectations in school. *Students who fail to follow our COVID-19 expectations will be sent to the school administrator, who will contact parents.*

- **Maintain 3 feet of social distancing in school**
- **Always wear your mask in school (correctly) – Covering your nose & mouth**
- **Wash & dry or sanitize your hands (regularly)**

D.P.S.C.D. Dress Code Guidance - Students can't wear the following things in school.

- Ripped, torn, or shredded jeans are not acceptable.
- Clothing that is either revealing or provocative, showing the abdomen region or cleavage. T-shirts or halter-tops, biker pants, or pants allowed to sag below the waistline.
- Bedtime attire such as pajamas, undershirts, or undergarments as outerwear.
- Students' clothing or tattoos may not display statements or pictures related to the use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco products or that promote hate and/or violence or signify gang affiliations.
- Jewelry or similar artifacts that are obscene or may cause disruptions to the educational environment.
- Hats, caps, bandanas, do-rags, hair rollers, hair curlers, plastic hair bags, hairnets, hair bonnets, and sweatbands except headwear worn for legitimate religious and cultural purposes.
- Flip-flops, Crocs, house slippers, steel-toe-shoes or boots, or any other type of footwear that could constitute a safety hazard.

To eliminate issues or concerns with clothing, students can still wear our designated school uniform. Please visit our school website under the category entitled "School Uniform" for more details.

Student School Entry & Exit Doors –

- K-2nd Grade – Door # 1 (Main building)
- 3rd – 5th Grade – Door # 3 (Main building)
- 6th – 8th Grade – Door # 1 (Annex building)

School Visitors – All school visitors must have their temperature taken first then report directly to the main office for assistance. *Visitors are not allowed to go beyond the main office without getting permission from the main office.*

Early Pick Up – If you need to pick up your child early, you must report to the main office first, sign your child out, and our office support team will call for your child to report to the main office to go home. *Parents aren't allowed to go directly to their child's classroom to pick them up.*

Dismissal Pick Up – If you pick up your child from school at the end of the day, you may park on Jos Campau Street, Maine Street, and in front of our school (Davison Service Drive). However, you aren't allowed to enter our school parking lot during dismissal time, park in our school bus lanes on Maine Street, or double park on any streets surrounding our school. *If you violate any of these rules, Detroit Police Department or Detroit Public School Police Department will issue you a citation ticket.*
