

# 5 THINGS PARENTS NEED TO KNOW ABOUT STATE ASSESSMENTS

- 1** Michigan's request to waive all state assessments was denied by the US Department of Education but parents have the option to take the test or not.
- 2** For DPSCD schools, testing begins the week of April 26th for our 8th-11th grade students, if you choose to have your students tested.
- 3** In person learning, including the Learning Centers, will resume by April 26th. However, if COVID numbers are too high for schools to open, schools will be open for testing.
- 4** Based on federal and state requirements, employees will be present to assist with testing.
- 5** Any additional questions should be directed to your school's principal.
