#### SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS FOR YOUR SCHOOL TO PARTICIPATE:

- Commitment that your school will provide a contestants for both the Poetry Slam and Poster Contest both must be SENIORS
  - o Deadline: Wednesday, January 27

## REQUIREMENTS FOR YOUR SENIOR STUDENT TO PARTICIPATE IN POETY SLAM:

- Submit your Poetry Slam and Poster Contestants
  - Must fill out contestant sheet provided
  - o Deadline: Friday, January 29
- Commitment that your senior will adhere to the guidelines set forth for the competition:
  - o The theme of "Powering Humanity." must be present
  - The performance must be between one minute and thirty seconds (1:30) and two (2) minutes.
  - Understanding that the performance/presentation will be judged based on specific criteria:
    - Adherence to the Topic/Theme/ Research(scored 1-10)
    - Originality/Creativity (scored 1-10)
    - Online Presence (scored 1-10)



- Time restraints
  - Performances that are 1:30 2:00 will receive 10 points
  - Performances that are 2:01 2:15 will receive 5 points
  - Performances that are 2:16 2:30 will receive o points
  - Performances less than 1:30 or longer than 2:30 will be disqualified
- Understanding that while we encourage free speech use of profane or intolerant language is not permitted
- Understanding that each performance/presentation needs to be created and performed by the participant

#### REQUIREMENTS FOR YOUR SENIOR STUDENT TO PARTICIPATE IN POSTER CONTEST

- Submit your Poster Contestants
  - o Must fill out contestant sheet provided
  - O Deadline: Wednesday, January 27
- Poster and paragraph description submitted by
  - Deadline: Thursday, February 4
  - o Submit several pictures of your poster to <a href="mailto:coeffler@pistons.com">coeffler@pistons.com</a>
  - o Contestant MUST be at present on Friday, February 12<sup>th</sup> virtually
  - o Public vote winners will be announced that day
- Commitment that your senior will adhere to the guidelines set forth for the competition:
  - Artwork should be on 11" by 17" poster paper
  - o The theme of "Powering Humanity" must be present
  - o Originality- the work must be done solely by the contestant
  - Creativity
