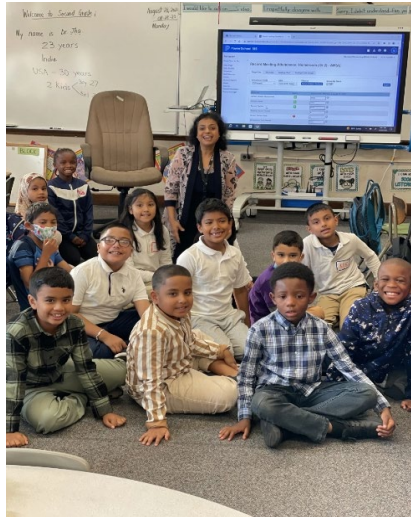

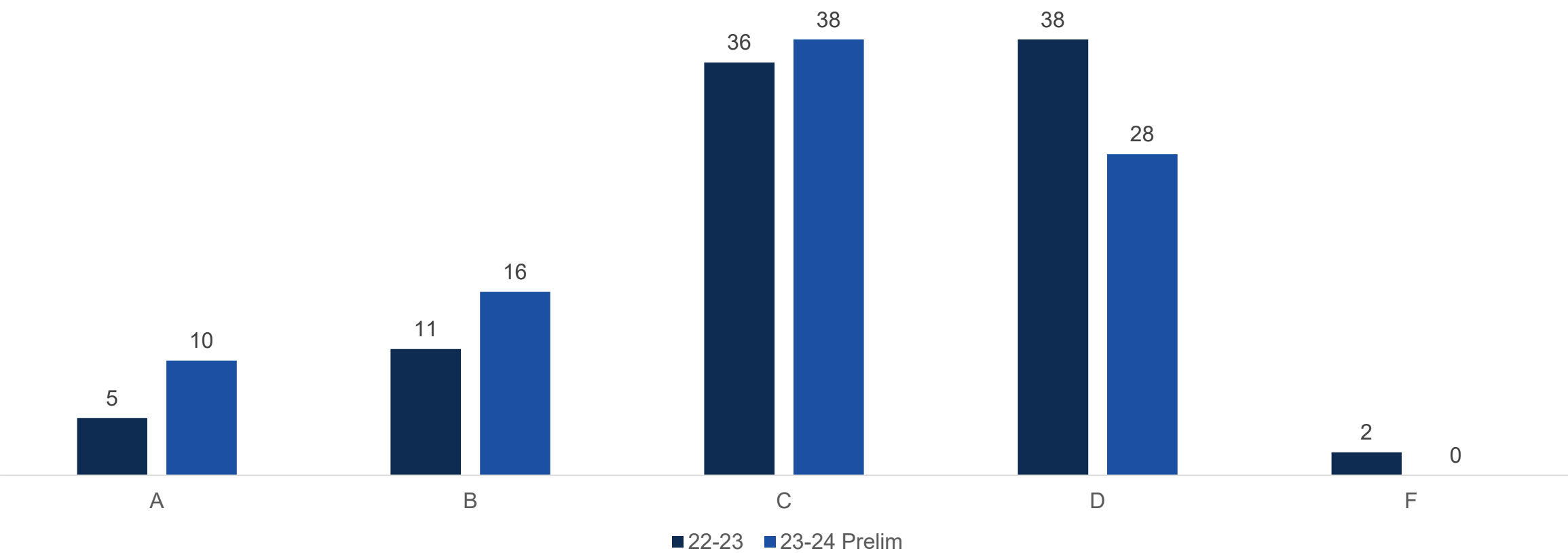


DPSCD District-Level Change



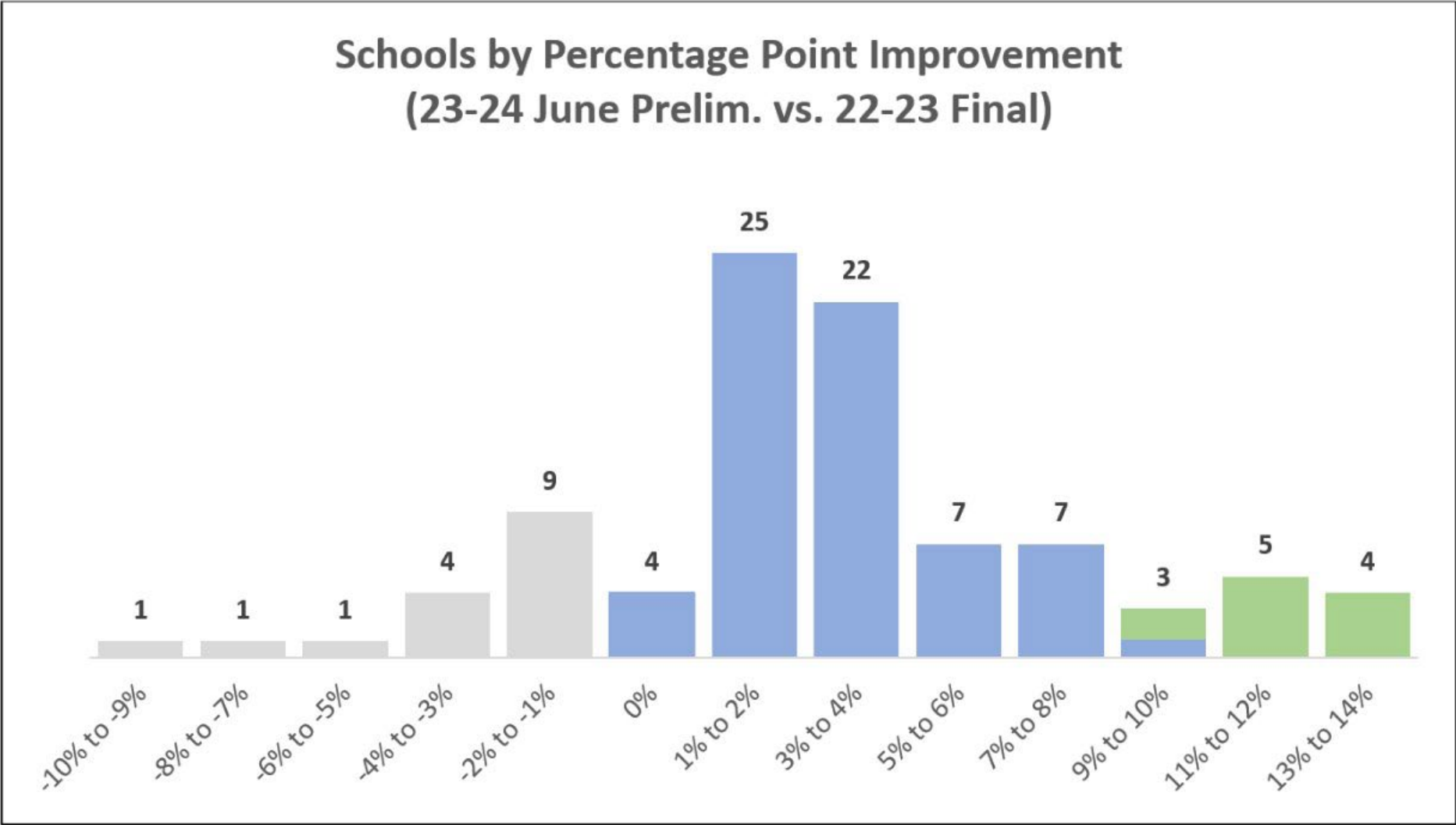
District-Level Results & Trends

The following chart will show the schools by School Grades percentage points improvements:



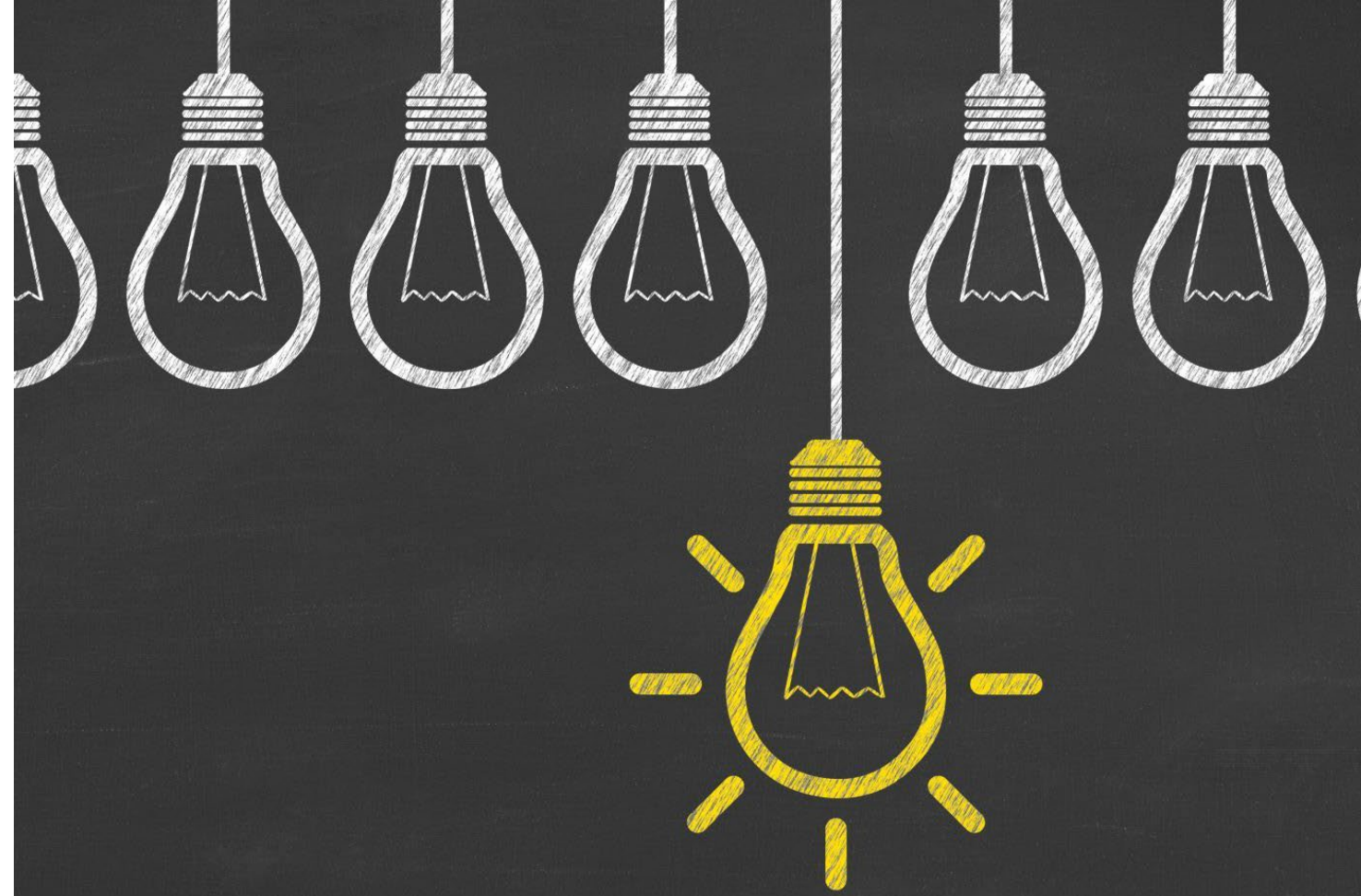
Powerful Shifts

We doubled the number of A schools, added 5 additional B schools, and *eliminated* Fs.

Visitor Protocol

- Go to the Main Office: Ring the Buzzer, State your name, organization (if applicable), who are you there to see.
- Check in at the Main Office: Bring your DPSCD issued id and sign in in the main office or with security.
