

## APPLICATION & AUDITION PROCESS

All students entering Grades 6 – 8 and applying to a Middle School Arts Conservatory Program or entering Grades 9 – 12 applying to Detroit School of Arts will be required to submit a formal application and attend an audition.

Each school will contact and schedule an audition directly with prospective students.

Acceptance to DSA requires each student pass an academic screening.
