
Directions: Children should complete 1 -2 assignments per week. Each assignment can

be extended by using things in the home to help with the lesson.


Suggestions for extensions to the assignments:

- 1. After a lesson on a letter, have children locate that letter on labels in the home.
- 2. When learning colors, Play "Eye Spy" around the house. Say the color for the week is red, then you look around the house or place something around the house that is red and say "Eye Spy with my little eye something red" and have the child look for it.
- 3. Read to your child daily. Have them point to pictures, repeat words, repeat sounds, try to guess what is going to happen in the story. Ask who, what, when, where questions. You can also have celebrities read to your child online at www.storylineonline.net
- 4. Have the children play the matching game with homemade number, letter or color cards.
- 5. For Science you can go for a walk outside and talk about the trees, flowers, insects, bugs, and the temperature.
- 6. Extend the rhyming lesson by finding things around the house that rhyme.
- 7. Extend the lesson on shapes by having children see the shapes of items around the house.
- 8. Extend writing by having children use house flour on a cookie sheet and make their lines. Or provide them with paper and pretend you are ordering food at restaurant and let them squiggle write. Your order down. Then, have them tell you what they wrote.



















Each player receives a BINGO board and bingo chips to cover the board. Place picture cards in a bag to draw from.


Either a player or the teacher can be the BINGO caller. Choose a game type:

- T or I shaped


Call out the body part but do not show the BINGO players. Players must find that body part on their board and cover it. The first player to correctly call out BINGO is the winner!


