




Times Square - 42nd Street







Los Angeles is a large city in California. It is often called the City of Angels.


Explorers went to Los Angeles in the 1700s. Railroads reached the city in the 1800s. The people found oil there. **Movies** were made later.

World-Class City


Los Angeles is **famous** for many things. Some are sports and schools. It has important harbors and airports. It is a world-class city.
