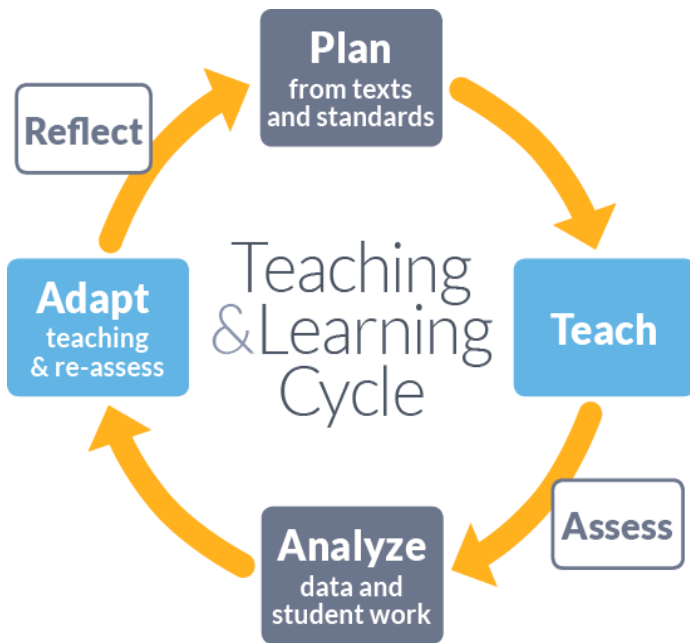


Aligning to the Common Core



Planning from Standards in Math

Focus: strongly where the standards focus

Coherence: think across the grades, and link to major topics within the grades

Rigor: in major topics, pursue with equal intensity: conceptual understanding, procedural skill and fluency, and application

Planning from Texts in ELA

Regular practice with **complex text** and its **academic language**.

Reading, writing, and speaking grounded in **evidence from the text**, both literary and informational

Building knowledge through **content-rich nonfiction**
