PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING

- Students who register for Summer Learning must commit to attending programming throughout the summer and must attend at least 70% of their scheduled learning days.
- Summer Learning is not a drop-in program. It is important for students to attend daily to receive the full benefits of the program.
- Current Pre-K Students: Students who will be entering Kindergarten in the fall may participate in the District's Kindergarten Bootcamp program sign up here.
- K-8 Students: All K-8 DPSCD students are eligible to participate in Summer Learning.
 - Students will attend Summer Learning in-person at their assigned summer site locations. Summer Site Assignments and Bell Schedules are listed on page 3 of this application.
 - Students will participate in AM Academics and PM Enrichment. Students must attend for the full day.
 - If your student has an IEP, please note that their site assignment may change. If you are assigned to a new site, you will be notified by your child's ESE Teacher of their updated summer school placement.

• High School Students: Submit this application <u>ONLY</u> if the student has been identified as needing Credit Recovery by their School Counselor. If you are unsure if you need credit recovery, please contact your Counselor.

- High School Summer Learning consists of Credit Recovery ONLY. Students will access their classes virtually.
- If in-person support is needed, students may visit their assigned summer site for assistance. Summer Site Assignments and Bell Schedules are listed on page 6 of this application.
