How to Enroll

1 Enrollment Packet*

- Also available in Spanish, Arabic, Bengali
- As-Needed-Forms
- Special forms for Kindergarteners and students with medical conditions
- Kindergarteners must be 5 by Sep. 1 (or Dec. 1 with a waiver)

2 Required Documents

- Birth Record
- Immunization or Waiver
- Proof of Address
- Parent/Guardian Photo ID
- Student Academic Record



Below are acceptable forms of required documentation for the enrollment process.

BIRTH RECORD

- Birth certificate (preferred)
- Baptismal or religious certificates showing the date of birth
- Court records
- Governmental records (county, military, passport, immigration)
- Adoption records
- Doctor or hospital records with a sworn statement
- Family records (e.g. an entry in a family bible)

Notarized affidavit is required for birth record documents other than an original birth certificate.

- Government-issued photo ID
- Public assistance documents
- Official government mail
- Detroit ID
- W2 or pay stub

The following documents are required in addition to the completed and signed enrollment form. They should be provided before the child's first day of school but must be submitted no later than 30 days from the first day.
