
Why I take pride in serving as Principal at Paul Robeson Malcolm X Academy:








How to Enroll

- 2 Required Documents
 - Birth Record
 - Immunization or Waiver
 - Proof of Address
 - Parent/Guardian Photo ID
 - Student Academic Record
