# What is a Petition?

- The petition is a process for **8<sup>th</sup>-grade** students who took the exam and applied for entrance into a Detroit Public Schools Community District Examination High School but did not receive their desired placement.
- For applicants who got into any school or no school.
- School administrators make all petition decisions. Your petition form will be sent only to schools selected in the form.
- All petition decisions are final.

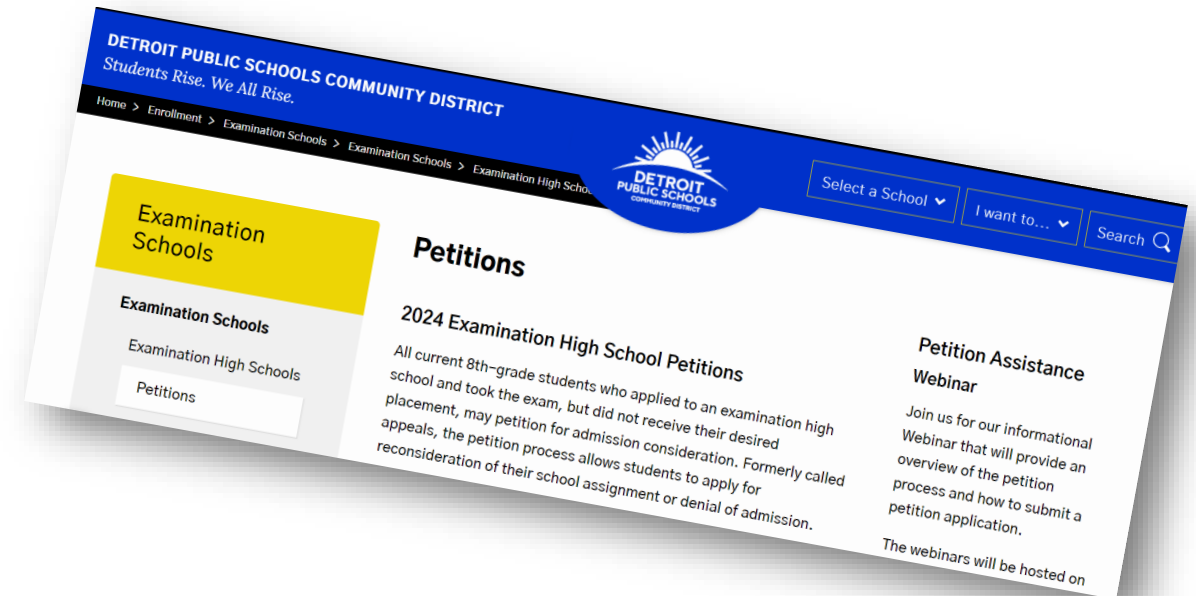

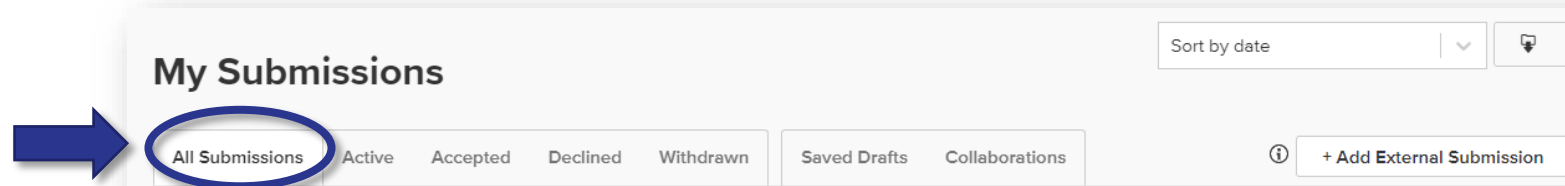

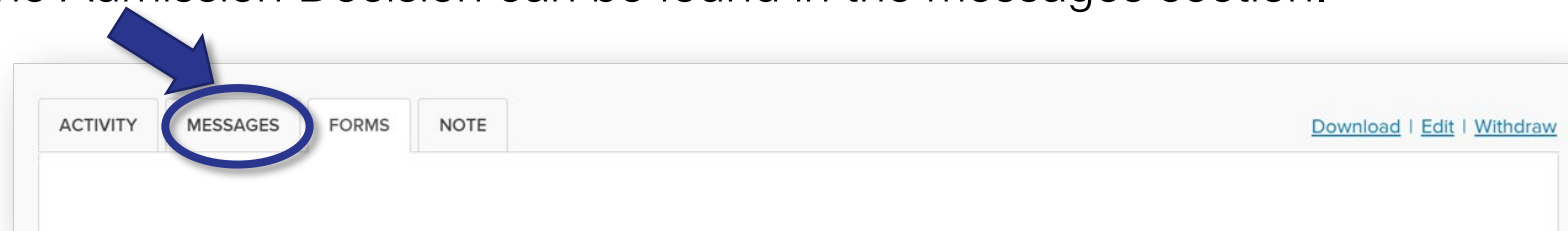
# Round 1 Decisions

# How To Find Your Admissions Decision

1. Check the email address associated with your Submittable account **OR**
2. Log into Submittable using the email and password associated with your account at [dpscd.submittable.com/login](https://dpscd.submittable.com/login)
3. Select **Submissions**



4. Under the tab **All Submissions**, click on the applicant's underlined name
5. Select **Messages**. The Admission Decision can be found in the messages section.



# Understanding the Application Score

- Your application scores were sent via Submittable and emailed on **Jan. 26**
- The message shares your percentile rankings on the overall application, the subcomponents of the application, and the subcomponents of the exam.
- We encourage you to review this information to assist in preparing for the petition application.

# Petition Overview

Round 1

# Petition Requirements

1. Student-authored essay
2. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation
3. An Artifact or third Letter of Recommendation
4. Recommended: Most recent card from 2023-24 school year

## Key Deadlines

- Petition: 11:59 p.m. Friday, February 16
- Reference Forms: 11:59 p.m. Friday, February 23

# Essay

- A student-authored essay answering the guided question
- Written toward their schools(s) of choice
- 750 words maximum length

## Guided Question

- Why are you a strong candidate for the school(s) you have selected?

## Tips for Applicants

- Write a new, original essay for your petition.
- You may draft the essay in Microsoft Word, Google Docs, etc., then copy/paste it into the form. Do not provide links to the essay.
- Review the application score information that was emailed to you on Jan. If applicable, address possible reasons for not getting accepted.
- Do a final review for grammar, style and content.



# Student References

There are two ways for applicants to provide support for their petition. Applicants may choose either method for each reference.

## 1 Enter the reference's email addresses

Submittable will send an email to the reference. You will receive a link to complete a short evaluation form and either type or attach their recommendation letter.

## 2 Upload recommendation letters

There are pre-written letters provided to the applicant by their reference(s).

## Who may write a recommendation letter?


- Teacher, principal, coach, mentor, community member, etc.
- The essay should be written by someone who can speak about the student
- We recommend that one letter come from a teacher in a core academic subject area
- Immediate family members may not submit recommendations on the student's behalf

# Reference and Recommendation Tips to Share


- Contact your reference/recommender in advance to confirm their ability to meet the response deadline.
- Applicants should write a note to their reference in the application to remind them of who they are and what qualities they would love for them to highlight.
- Applicants can track whether their references have responded by logging into Submittable.
- The reference request can be sent before the petition is submitted. Sending the form early gives recommenders more time to work on their letter.

# Student Artifact

In lieu of a third letter of recommendation, applicants may submit an artifact that provides support for their petition application.

The artifact(s) can be used to highlight a student's talents, provide substantiation for an award or accomplishment mentioned in their essay, or any other information the student wants to highlight about themselves.

A wide array of file types will be accepted.

## Artifact Examples

- Student artwork
- Student performance audio or video
- Athletic footage
- Photos of the student or their awards
- Any other digital file that can be uploaded

# Academic Records

You will have the option to upload updated report cards. We **STRONGLY** recommend that you upload fresh report cards/transcripts with your petition form.

Many students were declined due to insufficient academic records. Exam high school administrators review academic records when making petition decisions.




## Additional Tips

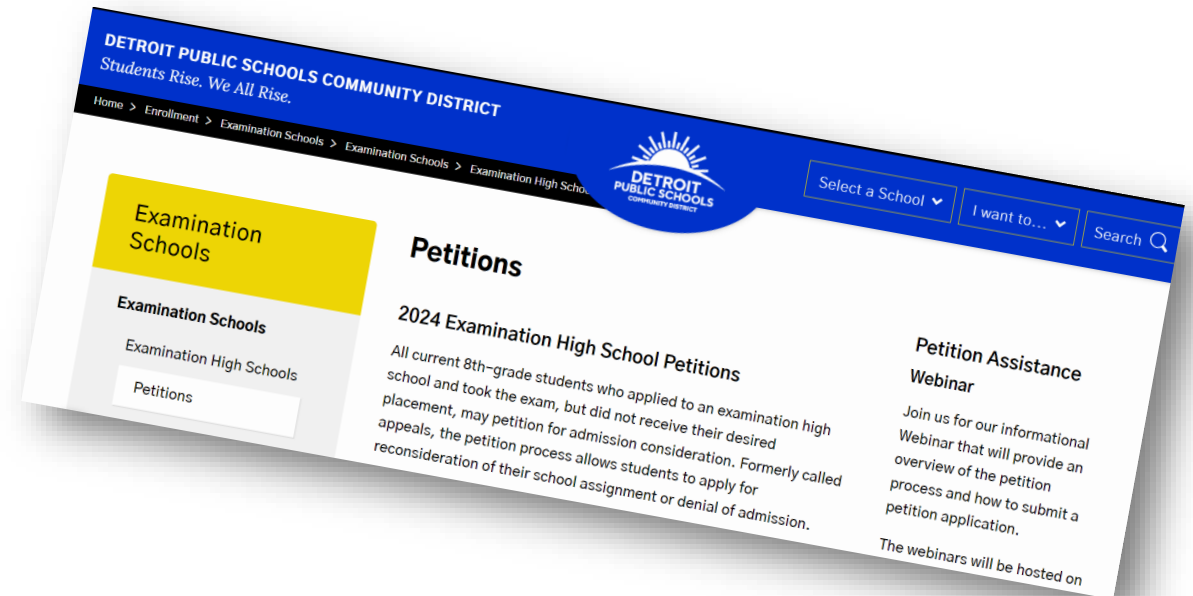
