



Program Overview: Little Caesars is excited to partner with Detroit Public Schools for a Fall Student Internship - Work-Based Learning Program. This program was established to provide exposure to various areas of business and information technology for students in grades 11 and 12. The program was developed to provide work-based learning experience that aligns with the student's career pathway program and for the business to gain useful insights, perspectives and support on key projects from the students. The program goals are to teach student learners workplace readiness skills, develop job specific skills, personal responsibility, gain exposure to the corporate world and foster working relationships with adults in the workplace.

Participating Schools: Cass Technical High School, Central High School, East English Village Preparatory Academy High School, Henry Ford High School, King High School, Renaissance High School and Southeastern High School.

Participating Career Pathways: Business and Information Technology

Program Benefits to Students & Little Caesars:

Program Highlights: The program runs Tuesday, October 12 – Thursday, December 2. Students will be expected to participate in orientation on 10/12/21 where they will learn more about the company culture, business and internship objectives, and meet their supervisor. There will be a virtual check in session halfway through the internship and the program will conclude on Thursday, December 2 with in-person student presentations highlighting their internship experience.

Outside of the two in-person required meetings, students will work remote during their in 8 week grant-funded internship program. Students will work 10 hours per week, Monday-Friday (2-4 pm timeframe or 3-5pm depending on their class schedules). Depending upon supervisor business hours, student work schedules may vary. *Students will receive paid stipend from Detroit Public Schools Community District.*

- Essay (1,500 words or less) answering:
 - a. Why are you interested? What are your career interests or goals and how do you think the Little Caesars Internship Program fits into your future plans?
 - b. What do you bring to the table? Do you have experience in English, math, or statistics? What other knowledge, skills or abilities do you have that would make you a fit for the role?
- You can apply for up to (3) positions.

- Please only submit one email with all the required information.
