BUILDING POSITIVE CULTURE AT HOME

EXPECT RESPECT

The goal of Expect Respect is to create a positive climate and culture through the expectation that we treat each other with kindness, understanding, and respect one another's differences. CHARACTER TRAITS: Responsibility, Respect, Kindness, Generosity, Citizenship, Self-Control, Honesty, Compassion, Cooperation, Acceptance

TIPS FOR PARENTS:

Respect each other, including each other's space and belongings \cdot Listen to each other and learn how to work out problems without confrontation

 \cdot Spend time together as a family and celebrate each other's successes and support each other through the sad times.

MENTORING PROGRAMS

Mentoring relationships exists between one individual in need of guidance and another individual who is both capable and willing to provide that guidance. The goal of this relationship is to help the student in his/ her personal development.

TIPS FOR PARENTS:

 \cdot Share with your child how mentors/role models have impacted your life, including the successes and challenges you experienced.

 \cdot Identify objectives for the mentoring relationship, such as participating in activities that help expose your child to new things and places.

• Assist your child in researching potential mentors that share your child's interests or could serve as a source of inspiration.

MINDFULNESS

Mindfulness is a mental state achieved by focusing one's awareness on the present moment, while calmly acknowledging and accepting one's feelings and thoughts.

TIPS FOR PARENTS:

 \cdot Practice deep breathing techniques. This can be done by taking 5 deep breaths slowly in through your nose and out through your mouth. Allow your child to take breaks periodically to refocus.

 \cdot Set aside time when the family can disconnect from the outside world (no cellphones) and relax.

• Modeling self-care for your child is crucial. Take time for yourself and allow your child to do the same. You can do things such as taking a bubble bath, going for a walk, or meditating.

Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS)

PBIS provides a safe school environment; builds positive relationships; celebrates favorable behavior; and addresses the academic and social emotional needs of students.

TIPS FOR PARENTS:

 \cdot Establish clear expectations at home. Keep your "house rules" similar to school expectations. The key is to be fair and age appropriate when you reinforce the expectations.

 \cdot Create routines for your family. Organize the day so your child knows what is happening. Be clear about changes or new events. Give your child a helpful transition warning to let them know what is coming next.

• Communicate clearly what behavior you want your child to demonstrate. Phrase directions in the positive, telling your child what you want them to do, not what you don't want them to.

SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING (SEL)

SEL is a process used to understand and manage emotions; set and achieve positive goals; feel and show empathy for others; establish and maintain positive relationships; and make responsible decisions.

The five core competencies associated with Social Emotional Learning: Self- Awareness, Self- Management, Social Awareness, Relationship Skills, Responsible Decision Making.


TIPS FOR PARENTS:

 \cdot Acknowledge your child's fears, emotions, and thoughts by asking about them and listening to their response.

 \cdot Nurture your child's self-esteem through praise, compliments, and celebrations.

 \cdot Help your child understand that problem solving and trying their best helps develop their skills and personal growth.


