“Greetings my future 9th grade peers. This is your class representative and I’m here to share with you about focusing on the future.

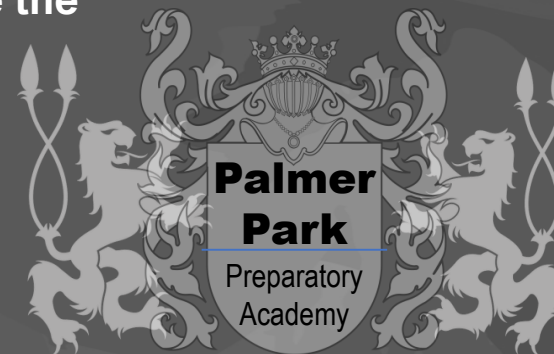
Focusing on the future can mean lots of things depending on who you ask. But for us, looking towards the future means looking into our high school years which is a new chapter in our lives.
