Daily Class Schedule

TSM operates on a **Block schedule**.

- Students will attend four 85-minute classes on Mondays & Thursdays (Cycle B days) and four 85-minute classes on Tuesdays & Fridays (Cycle C days).
- On Wednesdays (Cycle A day), they will attend all eight (8) classes (40-minutes ea.).
- There will be a 45-minute lunch period every day, Monday-Friday.
- Passing time between classes is 5 minutes.

Transportation

Students who are not dropped off to school by car can come to school by foot, bike or city bus. Free DDOT bus passes will be in the main office. Pick-up/drop-off and parking passes for students and families will be shared when we **Huddle**. Accessibility concerns should be addressed with **Dean Watts**.

Social Emotional Supports

Also at the **Huddle**, Marygrove Huskies will learn about how our school-based therapist, Ms. Aniqua Bailey, along with Ms. Cherice Redwine, our school counselor, provide wraparound support services.

DPSCD Virtual Academy

Per DPSCD Superintendent Dr. Vitti's email to families, DPSCD is offering a separate online school for students that may need to attend school virtually. The Virtual School will only be available to students who were not chronically absent (missed fewer than 18 or more days of school) and passed all of their classes in the second semester ('20-21).

If your student qualifies, their doctor must submit a medical waiver documenting why they cannot attend school in person through this application link.

As with other surveys, your student must use their student login information to complete the survey.

Please note that your student will not learn with Marygrove teachers in the Virtual School. If your student enrolls in the Virtual School, they do maintain their seat at Marygrove for a full school year. If accepted into the Virtual School, they are committing for a semester, and they can change to in-person for second semester.
