Construction Update: The Marygrove College campus is alive with lots of activity, much of which includes the ongoing renovation of the Liberal Arts building where TSM is located. In addition to new, larger classrooms, science labs and maker spaces (all with brand new furniture) on both the second and third floors, we will have an entirely new cafeteria for students, a dining room and large group workshop space for staff, and a new gymnasium!

I will keep you updated as progress is made. Please note that the second floor Main Office, Parent Resource Center and administrative offices will remain on the second floor until Summer 2022 when the administrative wing and welcome center are built.

I hope that you are fully enjoying this summer and taking time to relax. This abbreviated school newsletter is designed to share some key information about the next school year and to allow you time to prepare.

However, due to pandemic-related delays that are impacting almost every facet of life, both the cafeteria wing and gymnasium will have a delayed opening until January 2022.

I am working closely with The Marygrove Conservancy and DPSCD Central Office to adequately plan alternative space usage until these two facilities are completed.

As a reminder, the 2021-2022 school year begins on Tuesday, September 7, 2021 and we are planning for a return to in-person learning. Further details of our district's requirements for masks and other COVID-related protocols will be shared closer to the start of the school year.

Daily Class Schedule

TSM operates on a **Block schedule**.

- Students will attend four 85-minute classes on **Mondays & Thursdays** (Cycle B days) and four 85-minute classes on **Tuesdays & Fridays** (Cycle C days).
- On **Wednesdays** (Cycle A day), they will attend all eight (8) classes (40-minutes ea.).
- There will be a 45-minute lunch period every day, Monday-Friday. 
- Passing time between classes is 5 minutes.

Transportation

Students who are not dropped off to school by car can come to school by foot, bike or city bus. Free DDOT bus passes will be in the main office. Pick-up/drop-off and parking passes for students and families will be shared when we **Huddle**. Accessibility concerns should be addressed with [Dean Watts](#).

Social Emotional Supports

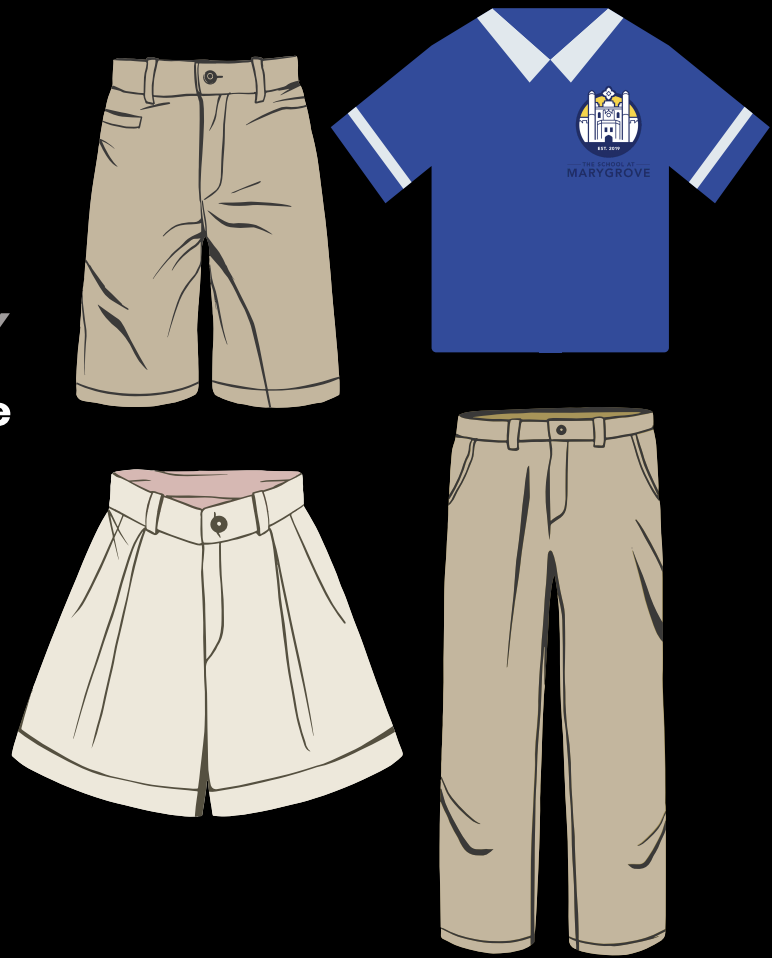

DPSCD Virtual Academy

Per DPSCD Superintendent Dr. Vitti's email to families, DPSCD is offering a separate online school for students that may need to attend school virtually. The Virtual School will only be available to students who were not chronically absent (missed fewer than 18 or more days of school) and passed all of their classes in the second semester ('20-21).

If your student qualifies, their doctor must submit a medical waiver documenting why they cannot attend school in person through [this application link](#).

As with other surveys, your student must use their student login information to complete the survey.

Please note that your student will not learn with Marygrove teachers in the Virtual School. If your student enrolls in the Virtual School, they do maintain their seat at Marygrove for a full school year. If accepted into the Virtual School, they are committing for a semester, and they can change to in-person for second semester.
