- Jeans and Western or School Club/Team/College T-Shirt

Articles of clothing which are NOT allowed

- Flip Flops/Slippers/Slides/Crocs
- Jeans (Except Fridays)
- Hats/Caps/Visors
- Bandanas
- Leggings/Jeggings
- No Hooded Sweatshirts
- No Sweatpants/Joggers
- Crop Tops or off the Shoulder Tops
- Excessively Tight or Revealing Clothing
- Sweatbands
- Ripped/Torn clothing
- Open Toed Shoes
