NORMALIZATION

What does it mean in a Montessori community?

Normalization is the term Montessori used to refer to children who are able to concentrate and work freely in the Montessori environment, exercising self-discipline and peace. Montessori said there were three stages each child goes through on the way to normalization.

Stages of Normalization

1. The child does something because they want to.
 2. The child does something because he/she is asked to do it.
 3. The child does something because they know it is right.
- Children who are normalized not only know the ground rules, they follow them because doing so leads to peace and harmony in their environment. They are patient with themselves and others. Normalized children are respectful of all things, living and non-living. They exercise self-control and self-discipline. In short, normalized children are independent which leads to greater learning.

“In the normalized child, his freedom to take an interest in all kinds of things, leads to his focusing his attention... on the knowledge he derives from them.” The Absorbent Mind, (Chap 22)
