ATTENDANCE: LAST WEEK 98.5%

Please ensure students are on time to school at 8:00 am. **After 8:10 am, DOOR 2 will be closed. ALL students will have to enter DOOR 1 and be signed in by an adult and marked TARDY.** Dismissal is at 3:10pm. Please make sure students are picked up on time. At 3:00pm parents will have to wait until dismissal of 3:10pm to retrieve students. We have an abundance of students being picked up regularly between 2:45 pm - 3:10pm daily which interrupts the environment.

To ensure the safety and supervision of students not picked up on time, our school has established clear guidelines for late pickups. If a student is not picked up within 15 minutes of dismissal or the end of an after-school activity, designated staff will supervise the student and attempt to contact parents/guardians. If contact cannot be made, DPSCD Public Safety will be involved. Parents are urged to provide accurate emergency contact information and adhere to pickup times. Repeated late pickups will require a meeting with the Principal to develop a plan of action and could result in a loss of privileges.

## Instructional Focus - Normalization/Assessments

Quarter 1 focuses on normalization where students create a sense of belonging in the environment. Students learn to work within the environment themselves and others.
