#### **New Online Learning Management Platforms and Applications**

Microsoft Teams is the educational platform we will use. It is the same platform used when COVID19 first hit and all schools were closed. Students will be automatically rostered into Teams and scheduled into their respective classes. The same classroom expectation is required throughout the day. Below you will find our Distribution Schedule. These are the curricular items needed for each student to be successful in school. Please plan to pick up items beginning Wednesday, September 9, 2020, and see schedule below.

Schoology (skoo/luh/jee or skoo/a/jee) is our new Online Library and Learning Management System (LMS) for curriculum resources that our district has adopted. We will utilize other digital tools like iReady, Max Scholar, and online resources to help us provide excellent instruction to all students. Teachers will be able to use Schoology to assign work, distribute reading assignments, access student progress reports, communicate with families and create an overall online classroom environment. Schoology will also make it possible for our District to better support Teachers by enabling them to share course resources as we support professional learning.

#### **Safety Protocols**

DPSCD has purchased and will deploy **PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)** for staff and students as part of the Re-Opening of schools. The first delivery of PPE has already taken place in preparation for the first day of school. The monthly deliveries include masks, hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes for all students, staff and classrooms, and signs detailing social distancing protocols while present in the building and on campus.

#### Daily Temperature Checks & Health Screenings

- Every student will have their temperature checked, prior to entering the school building daily.
- Please note any student or staff with a temperature at or above 100.4F will be sent home.
- Every student will be asked to complete a health questionnaire upon entry into the school building daily.
- Every student must practice social distancing at all times; always remaining at least six feet apart. Markers are placed both inside and outside the building to assist students while waiting to enter and in hallways.

# 8:00AM – All tardy students must enter the Main Entrance Door AFTER 8:00AM

# **Main Office Hours**

- Main Office Hours for visitors are 8:00am 10:00am in the morning and 1:30pm-2:15pm for Early Dismissal.

  These hours are set to ensure safe Arrival and Dismissal procedures for our students and to prevent visitors from having interaction or interface with children while they transition throughout the building.
- Visitors may visit the Main Office beginning at 8:00am after all of our students have entered the building and have transitioned to class.
- Due to Social Distancing and Spacing Protocols, only three visitors are allowed in the Main Office at a time. Once individuals are helped and after they exit the building, other people will be allowed to enter.
- All visitors MUST wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth before they enter the building.
- Immediately upon entering the building, all visitors must have their Temperature Checked and go through the metal detectors at the Main Entrance.
