- K-8 Sites: Will offer in-person learning experiences only
- K-8 Hours: Student hours: 8:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. (4 hours); Lunch 12:30 p.m. - 1:00 p.m.
- K-8 Enrichment Hours: 1:00 p.m.-3:30 p.m. Extended Enrichment 3:30 p.m.-5:00 p.m.
- K-8 Transportation will be provided for all eligible students to a host site within proximity of their home school. Please be advised that transportation will be provided only for students who plan to attend both the academic program, which starts at 8:30 a.m. and the enrichment session which ends at 3:30 p.m. Parents who elect for their children to participate in the Extended Enrichment hour (3:30 p.m.- 5:00 p.m.) will be responsible for securing pick up arrangements.
