

Technology and Family Resource Hubs

The district has opened thirteen (13) Technology and Family Resource Hubs. The location of the Hubs and their hours of operation are noted in the chart below. These Hubs were created to expand and deepen direct support to families who continue to face challenges with online learning and broken tablets. If an issued tablet cannot be repaired or replaced with a new one, then the district will provide a laptop with a hotspot to families to ensure that online learning continues. The Hubs will also provide families with resources such as medical and mental health support, coats for the winter, assistance with utility bills, and COVID testing. Please note that the district's hotlines for homework support, mental health, and technology support will continue.
