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CURRICULUM DISTRIBUTION




- The process students will follow to retrieve their curriculum materials are as follows:

ACCESSING SAVVAS for ELA



Schoology is not the designated teaching and learning platform for 9-12 ELA. 9-12 ELA teachers and students will utilize the interactive Savvas (formerly Pearson) Realize platform to read interactively, take notes, engage in discussion threads, annotate texts, complete unit and selection assessments, and to complete any other ancillary work related to the literature instruction within the curriculum. Teachers will also utilize Teams for conferencing and synchronous teaching and learning. Savvas Realize can be facilitated through a live Teams session with screen sharing.
