IF YOU ARE SHARING A RIDE WITH OTHER SENIORS AND ONE PERSON TESTS POSITIVE IN THE CAR THE ENTIRE CAR WILL BE SENT HOME BECAUSE YOUR EXPOSURE WILL HAVE BEEN AT LEAST 15 MINUTES. Plan time for testing- it is not an excuse to be late.

Gates will open at 9:00 for guests and will close at 9:45 until 10:15 for processional of the graduates. Gates will be reopened for guests at 10:15.
