DPSCD 2023 - 2024 ASSESSMENT CALENDAR

PURPOSE

This assessment calendar outlines all required national, state, and District assessments for the upcoming, 2023–2024 school year. With improved 1- to-1 device access and the expansion of online tests, we will continue to structure and consistently align our administration dates across both state and District assessments to minimize disruptions to instruction and improve overall assessment data quality, comparability, and use.

Because national and state assessment requirements may change throughout the year, this calendar will be updated as needed.

IMPORTANT FEATURES

SHIFTING TOWARDS AN EARLIER START TO STATE TESTING

Instead of beginning M-STEP administrations in the last week of April, schools will begin administering those assessments one week earlier than last year. While there will be some overlap with the College Board makeup testing, there will be more time for students, particularly those in 3rd grade, to complete M-STEP Reading earlier.

CONTINUED TARGETED ADMINISTRATION DATES

With the deployment of students' 1:1 devices, schools will be able to more consistently administer assessments on designated days. AM-STPE dhering to the targeted administration dates minimizes disruptions to learning and makes it easier for Detroit families to become familiar with one common assessment calendar.

ADDITION OF FALL COLLEGE BOARD ASSESSMENTS FOR GRADES 8-11

Due to the shift to digital College Board assessments, students in grades 8–11 will have the opportunity to experience the new test platform and format in the fall. This will allow students to build familiarity with the test before the Spring administration and also provides teachers with actionable instructional supports that can be used to support students' academic goals.

ADDITION OF END- OF- COURSE ASSESSMENTS FOR GRADES 9-10

To reduce the variation in assessments used to measure student learning in core content areas in high school, the District is adding end- of- course assessments to the high school assessment system. These assessments are standards- aligned and will provide a better reflection of where students are in meeting their required learning targets.
