Give your child a lotion massage.

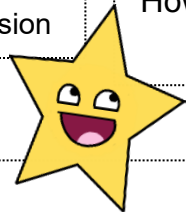
You can play soothing music

Fine Motor Fun

Play Peek-a-Boo with your child.
Then help your child do the
motions of Peek-a-Boo by
placing his/her hands over her
eyes as you say "peek-a-boo"
and pulling hands back as you
say "I see you!"
Encourage child to do.

Language

Playing games with your child encourages babbling.

Try a different spin on *Peek-a-Boo*. Use a favorite toy, like a ball, to play *Where's the Ball?* Show the ball to your child. Move the ball behind your back or out of the child's sight. Say, "Where's the ball?" Bring the ball from behind your back. Say, "Here it is!" Repeat.
(This game also teaches object permanence.)
