English Language Learners

Question: Will the District's full Reopening Plan be translated for Non-English-speaking families?

Answer: Yes. The District's Reopening Plan and other supporting documents will be translated in Spanish, Arabic, Hmong, and Bengali and can be found on the detroitk12.org/returntoschool webpage.

Question: Will the parent survey be translated for Non-English-speaking families?

Answer: Yes. The District's Survey to select face to face instruction or online learning has been translated in Spanish, Arabic, Hmong and Bengali. Families can select their preferred language via a drop-down menu in the top right corner of the survey. The District has also created a new Enrollment Form to collect the online or face to face learning selection from newly enrolled families, which is also translated. This is available at detroitk12.org/enrollnow.

Question: Will the District host presentations about the District's return to school in languages other than English?

Answer: Yes. In collaboration with the Office of Family and Community Engagement, the Office of Bilingual Education and related programs will host 4 sessions, in each of the District's main four other languages with interpreters to provide an opportunity for questions and answers, as well.
