The Detroit Public School Community District Board of Education and Superintendent are extremely disturbed with the most recent attempts of voting redistricting. Our concerns rest with the proposal to shift representation of Detroit outside of the city and beyond its minority Black and Brown citizens. We believe this proposal will not only negatively impact the city and its citizens, but also the public school district. The current redistricting proposals are yet another attempt in voter disenfranchisement. We demand that the current proposals be eliminated, and that all changes made will protect the identity of the city through majority representation of public officials.
