**HOW TO MAKE PUBLIC COMMENT**

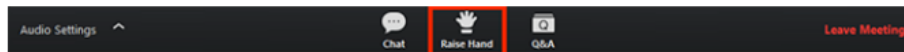
At the beginning of the meeting, the presiding officer will announce that registration for public comment is open. At that time, you can register for public comment as follows:

**If You Join By Computer:**

There are two ways to register for public comment if you join by computer.

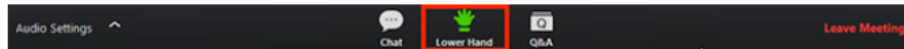
1. Click raise your hand, as shown below. The meeting presider will call on those who've raised their hand, in the order a hand was raised.

1. Click **Raise Hand** in the Webinar Controls.



2. The host will be notified that you've raised your hand.

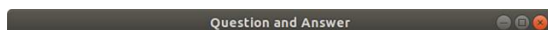
3. Click **Lower Hand** to lower it if needed.



**Note:**

- **Windows:** You can also use the **Alt+Y** keyboard shortcut to raise or lower your hand.
- **Mac:** You can also use the **Option+Y** keyboard shortcut to raise or lower your hand.

2. Click Q&A, as shown below. We will read aloud, within the time permitted, any public comment submitted using the Q&A feature.

**If You Join By Telephone:**

If you join by telephone, during the public comment registration period you can register by:

1. Calling (313) 873-4104 and give the last four digits of the phone number you used to call-in to the meeting. During the public comment period, we will unmute you by using the last four digits of your telephone number. (NOTE: You can also give your name if you like, but that is not required. We will require you to share, at a minimum, the last four digits of your telephone number).

Only persons who register during the public comment registration period either by: (i) Raising Hand (on-line); (ii) Q&A (on-line); or (iii) calling last four digits of telephone number to (313) 873-4104, will be called upon and/or recognized to give public comment during the meeting.
